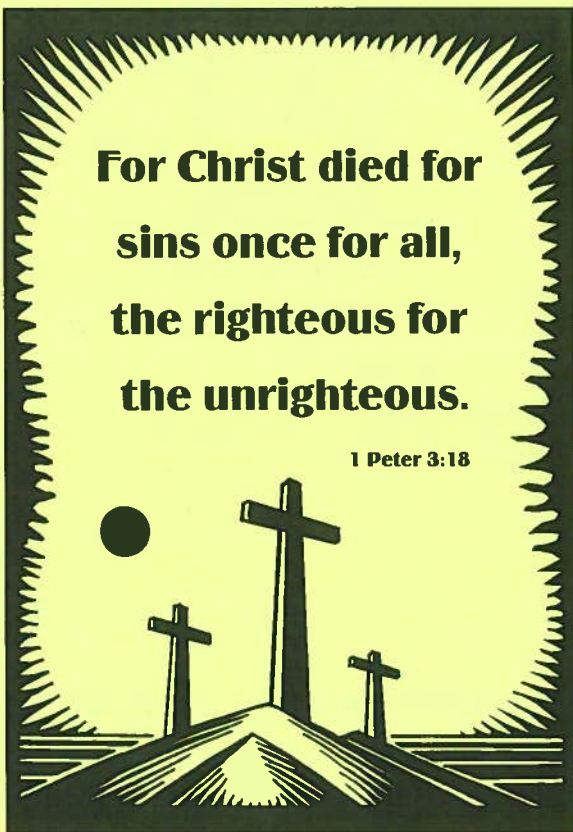

On April 11, 1855, Boston Sunday-school teacher Edward Kimball led 18-year-old shoe clerk, Dwight L. Moody, to a saving faith in Jesus Christ, at the Holton Shoe Store in Boston. A year and a half later, Moody moved to Chicago where he embarked on a preaching career, eventually becoming the most successful Gospel evangelist in his day.
