(Part 12 of a series, “Living in Light of Jesus’ Return!”)
I Thessalonians 5:1-11

We often refer to fellow believers as “sisters” and “brothers”. The Apostle Paul’s favorite name for believers was “brothers” (“brethren” in the KJV). He used this expression over 60 times in his letters, 27 of those times in 1 & 2 Thessalonians. Of course, this makes perfect sense since we, through faith in Jesus Christ, are in the same family of God! We *all* need family! This is true as well in the spiritual realm - we all need our *church* family - a *thriving* church family - for support, the exercising of spiritual gifts, fellowship, encouragement ... The essentials for a happy, thriving *earthly* family are the same as for a happy, thriving *church* family!
