**(Part 17 of a Series, “Living in Light of Jesus’ Return”)**  
**2 Thessalonians 3:6-15**

In this last section of 2 Thessalonians, the Apostle Paul deals with church problems (something that has gone on down through the centuries!). We need to recall that the church at Thessalonica was a young one - full of new believers. God told them through Paul, and is now telling us through the Word, that even while we await Jesus’ return, and in the midst of diversity and adversity, He wants order in the church!
