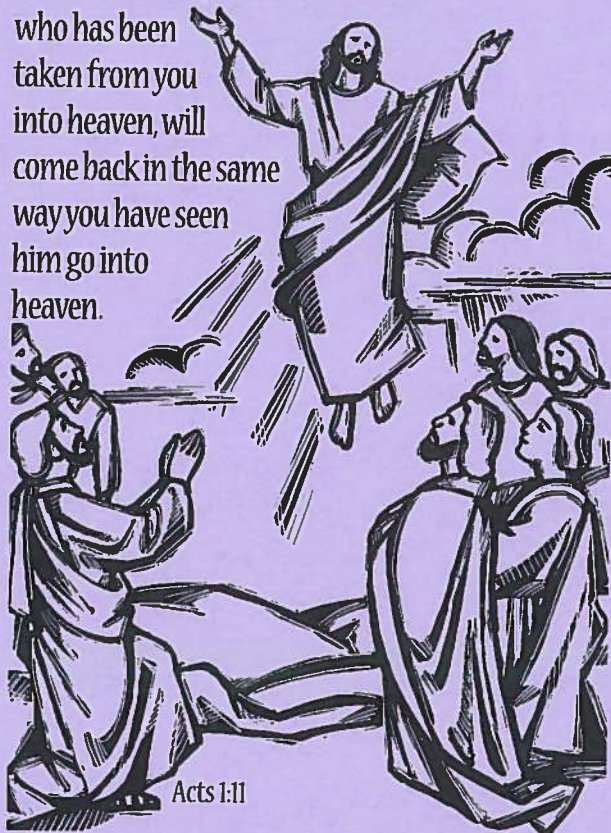

On January 13, 1836, Alexander Whyte was born in Forfarshire, Scotland. A Free Church of Scotland clergyman, in 1909 he became minister of the largest and most influential congregation of his denomination and New Testament professor at New College, Edinburgh. His aggressiveness at "weeding out" the lazy among both ministers and students earned him the title "the last of the Puritans."

CONFERENCE COST: (includes conference & Sat. afternoon meal) \$69 if we get 10 or more guys to go

NOTE: Please do not register for the conference "on your own". Once we get a final number of guys who want to go, we will register everyone at the reduced rate.

Estimated hotel cost (2 nights) for each guy (2 guys to a room) is \$100 total for the two nights. You will also need money for several meals and whatever else you want to purchase at the conference.

Leaving GBC AT 8 AM on Fri., April 17, & returning early evening on Sun., April 19. Will drive together, stay at same hotel (details coming).

DEADLINE IS JANUARY 14 to let Pastor John know you are definitely attending & give him the \$100 non-refundable deposit (per guy) for the conference/hotel fee. After January 14, the cost of the conference goes up \$10. Deadline #2 (\$110 non-refundable deposit) is February 15. Hotel reservations will be made on February 16.
