This Week in Church History...

On July 24, 1874, Oswald Chambers, evangelical Bible teacher, was born in Aberdeen, Scotland. The son of a Baptist pastor, Chambers was converted under the ministry of C.H. Spurgeon. In 1906-07, he toured the world, preaching among Methodist and Pentecostal Holiness groups, and worked with the Pentecostal League of Prayer from 1907-10. The last ministry of his brief years was as chaplain to the British troops stationed in Egypt. Chambers has been called an "evangelical mystic" by some; and nowhere does this dimension of his faith come out more prominently than in his devotional classic *My Utmost for His Highest*. He died in 1917 at the age of 43 from complications following an emergency appendectomy.

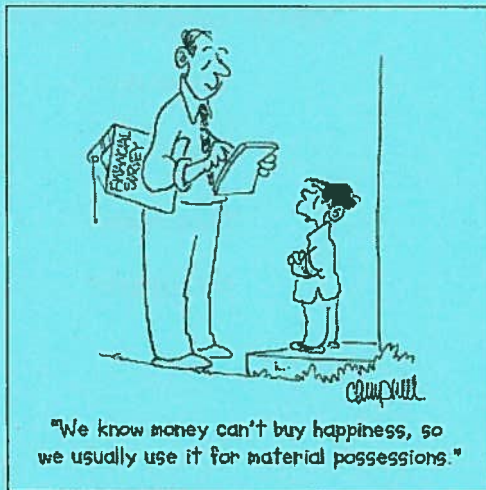
