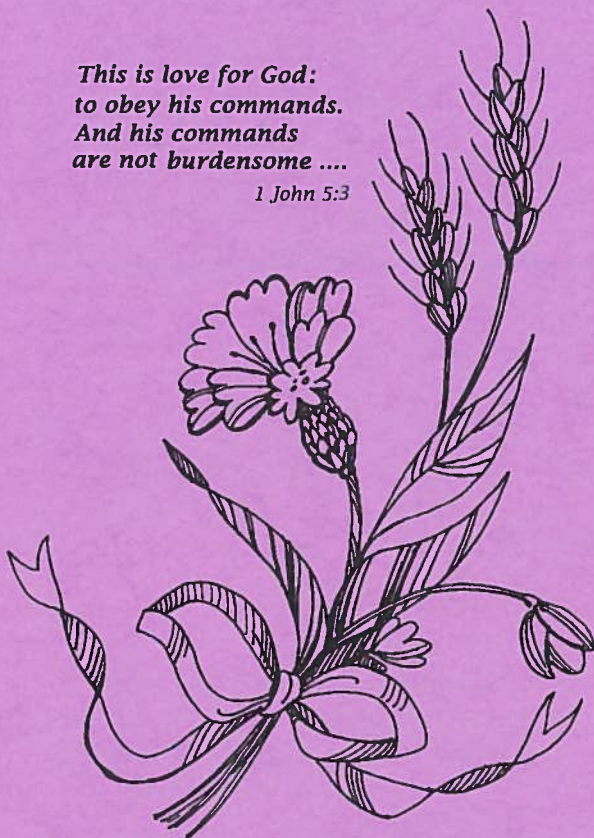

James 1:13-18

What is a “temptation”? It is an opportunity to accomplish something good in a bad way, out of the will of God.
