This Week in Church History...

On November 20, 1850, blind American hymn-writer Fanny Crosby (1820-1915) underwent a dramatic conversion experience at a Methodist revival meeting. Though always devout and religious from childhood, Miss Crosby described this special day in her 30th year by saying, "The Lord planted a star in my life and no cloud has ever obscured its light." In 1865, Miss Crosby began writing the first of thousands of hymn texts, many of which remain popular to this day, including "Rescue the Perishing," "Jesus, keep Me Near the Cross," and "All the Way My Savior Leads Me."
