On January 6, 1850, famed English Baptist preacher, Charles Haddon Spurgeon, at the age of 16, was converted to Christ. Spurgeon had walked into a Methodist Chapel to warm himself during a snowstorm. Less than 15 people were present and even the minister did not appear. A layman preached on the text in Isaiah 45:22: "Look unto me, and be ye saved..." Spurgeon did, and his life touched off a new era of evangelism in London.

of the form $\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B}$, where \mathbf{A} and \mathbf{B} are $n \times n$ matrices, \mathbf{A} is invertible and \mathbf{B} is symmetric. The matrix \mathbf{A} is given by

$$\mathbf{A} = \begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{M} & \mathbf{0} \\ \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{K} \end{bmatrix} \quad (1)$$

where \mathbf{M} and \mathbf{K} are the mass and stiffness matrices, respectively, of the system. The matrix \mathbf{B} is given by

$$\mathbf{B} = \begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{0} \\ \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{C} \end{bmatrix} \quad (2)$$

where \mathbf{C} is the damping matrix. The matrix $\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B}$ is then given by

$$\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B} = \begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{0} \\ \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{M}^{-1}\mathbf{C} \end{bmatrix} \quad (3)$$

The matrix $\mathbf{M}^{-1}\mathbf{C}$ is symmetric and positive semi-definite. The matrix $\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B}$ is then given by

$$\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B} = \begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{0} \\ \mathbf{0} & \mathbf{M}^{-1}\mathbf{C} \end{bmatrix} \quad (4)$$

The matrix $\mathbf{A}^{-1}\mathbf{B}$ is then given by
