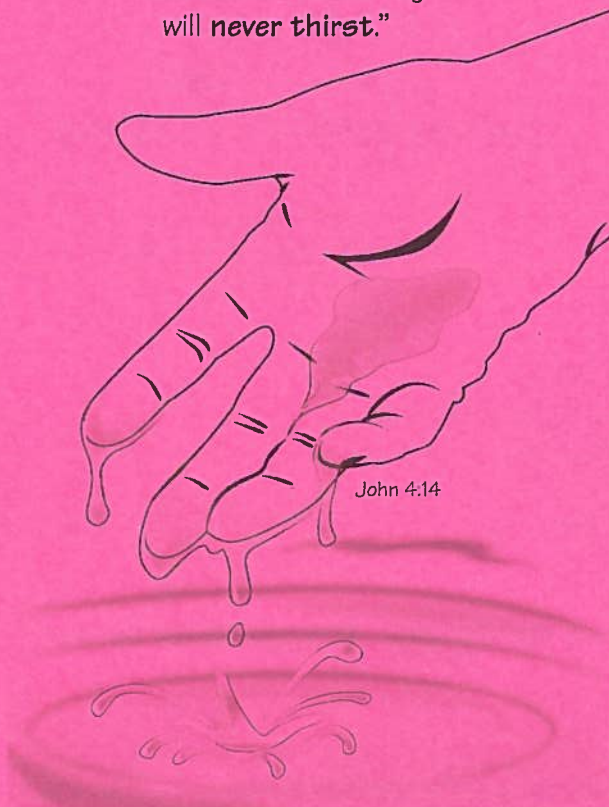

The court decided that a state could not make a law which would restrict a woman's right to have an abortion before the fetus is viable (after the sixth month). Since 1973, more than 50 million abortions have been performed in the United States.
