On January 29, 1685, the Edict of Nantes was revoked by Louis XIV, thus forcing a half million Huguenots (French Protestants) to flee their country. As a result, the mercantile economy was severely damaged, and criticism of absolute government in France began. (The edict was originally signed by Henry IV of France in 1598, after he became a Catholic, in order to stop the French Wars of Religion. It gave religious freedom to French non-Catholics.)

## **“Sharing the Gospel: The Salvation Verses!” (Part 3) Romans 3:21-26; 6:20-23**

On December 27, we looked at spreading the Gospel - the good news! - concerning Jesus Christ. There are people all around us who are on their way to Hell because they have not yet put their faith in Jesus Christ, Who died for them and rose from the dead.
