This Week in Church History...

On February 5, 1837, Dwight L. Moody, American evangelist, was born at Northfield, Massachusetts. At age 18, he gave his life to Jesus Christ through the testimony of his Sunday School teacher, Edward Kimball. Five years later, he left his job in his uncle's shoe repair shop to devote his life to Christian evangelism and education. On February 5, 1887, he founded the Chicago Evangelization Society, along with English-born educator Emma Dryer. This educational organization eventually grew to become Moody Bible Institute.

"Sharing the Gospel: The Salvation Verses!" (Part 4) Acts 4:1-13

On December 27, we looked at spreading the Gospel - the good news! - concerning Jesus Christ. We are told by our Lord to do this, and our sharing the Gospel is the only way that people are going to trust in Jesus! There are people all around us who are on their way to Hell because they have not yet put their faith in Jesus Christ, Who died for them and rose from the dead. We need to ask God for "Divine appointments" to share the Gospel, and then share it! There is an inherent blessing in doing so! We are looking together at some of the verses we all can and should use when we share the Gospel. We have already looked at John 3:16, Ephesians 2:8&9, Romans 3:23, and Romans 6:23.
