According to the decision of the Council of Nicea in AD 325, Easter is observed on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the spring equinox (March 21). This reckoning places Easter between March 22 and April 25 on any given year (this year, March 27; last year, April 5; in 2014, April 20; next year, April 16!) The last time Easter fell on March 27 was 2005!

### **This Week in Church History...**

On March 29, 1788, Charles Wesley (b. 1707), brother of the English founder of Methodism John Wesley, and himself known as "the sweet singer of Methodism," died. During his lifetime he wrote over 7,200 hymns, giving full expression to an evangelical, biblical faith. Among the dozens of his hymns that remain classics in Protestant hymnody are: "A Charge to Keep I Have," "Hail, Thou Long-Expected Jesus," "Jesus, Lover of My Soul," "O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing," "Soldiers of Christ, Arise", and "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today."
