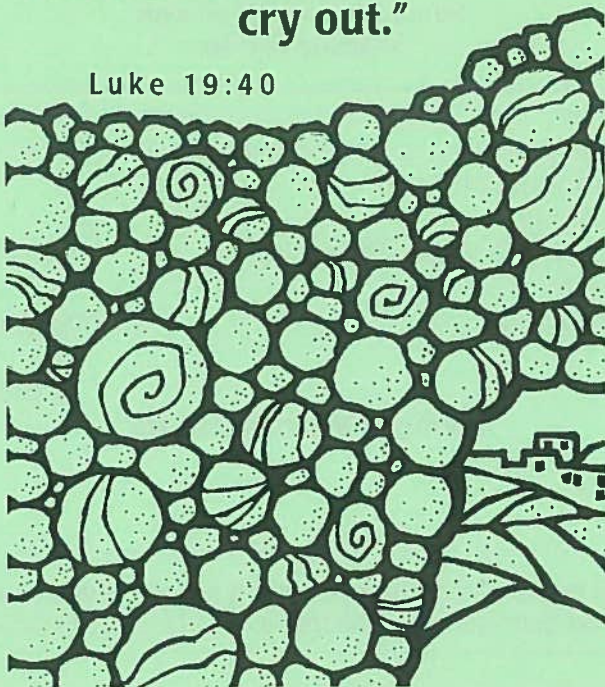

Her father's birthday was in June, so she chose to hold the first Father's Day celebration in Spokane on June 19, 1910.
