Sola Fide	(Only Faith)
Sola Scriptura	(Only Scripture)
Sola Christus	(Only Christ)
Sola Deo Gloria	(Only the Glory of God)

## **“I Know That I Know!”**

**(Part 20 of a Series in I John, “Genuine or Counterfeit?”)  
I John 5:13-21**

Benjamin Franklin (1706-1790), in a letter to Jean-Bapiste Leroy in 1789 wrote “In this world there is nothing can be said to be certain except death and taxes.” This is absolutely NOT true! According to the Scriptures, for the genuine believer in Jesus Christ, there are a number of things that are certain, a number of things that he/she *knows*! Last week, we learned that a genuine Christian *knows* that Jesus is God. Our passage today teaches us several other things we *know*!


