On January 29, 1685, the Edict of Nantes was revoked by Louis XIV, thus forcing a half million Huguenots (French Protestants) to flee their country. As a result, the mercantile economy was severely damaged, and criticism of absolute government in France began. The edict was originally signed by Henry IV of France in 1598, after he became a Catholic, in order to stop the French Wars of Religion. It gave religious freedom to French non-Catholics.
