“How to Be Blessed By God!”

**(Part 1 of a Series in Psalm 119, “Magnifying God’s Word!”)
Psalm 119:1-8**

Last Sunday, we found out that one of the things that our Risen Lord Jesus desires - and that we believers in Jesus should desire - is a high view of the Word of God. Psalm 138:2 tells us that God magnifies (lifts up, glorifies) His Word together with His Name! Thus, we begin a series in Psalm 119 today. Psalm 119 magnifies the Word of God.
