

This Week in Church History...

On May 1, 1873, David Livingstone (b. 1813), Scottish missionary and explorer, died. He began to study medicine and theology at age 17, and arrived as a missionary in South Africa ten years later. In 1857, he resigned from his sponsoring agency, the London Missionary Society, but returned to Africa under the British government to search for the source of the Nile and to eradicate the slave traffic. When he died, the natives found him on his knees. His body was returned to England, but his heart was buried in Africa.




