## This Week in Church History...

On December 31, 1384, John Wycliffe (b.1328), English reformer and theologian, died. Though raised in the Catholic church, Wycliffe was repulsed by the "Babylonian Captivity" (1305-77) of the papacy in Avignon, France, and embarrassed at having two popes during the Great Schism (1378-1417). In his disdain, Wycliffe turned to the Scriptures and early church fathers for guidance. He eventually developed his own view of the true church. Wycliffe maintained that every person is a servant of God, and that the church does not provide the only access to grace nor possess the right to unquestioned secular sovereignty. Known as "the Morning Star of the Reformation." Wycliffe received support for his ideas among the aristocracy in England, especially after 1380. His writings also had a major influence on England's poorer clergy, such as the Lollards, and on others, such as Czech scholar John Huss. Wycliffe spent his last four years in retirement, devoting himself to a new translation of the Bible - the first translation of the Scriptures into English.
