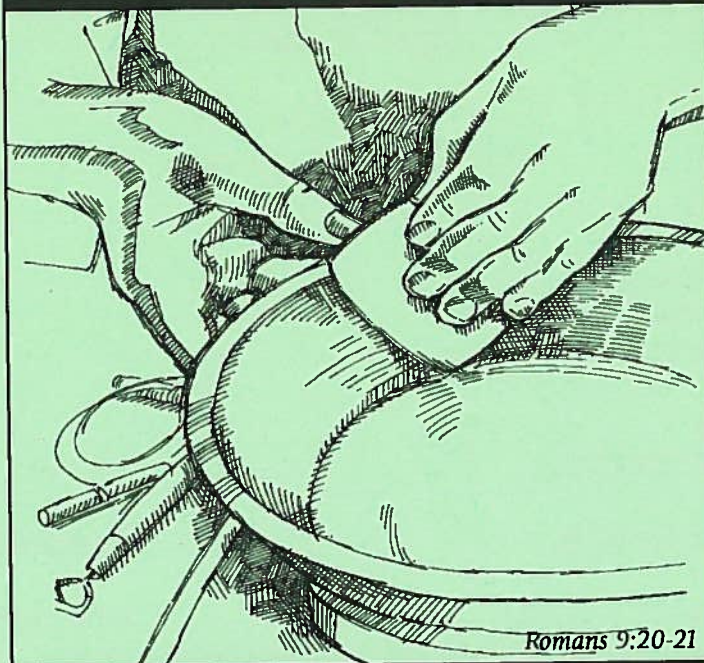

Romans 9:1-13

We pick up this morning our study in the great book of Romans, a study we were last in on March 10! In Romans 8, we learned that because of Jesus Christ and His death and resurrection in our behalf, we are free, as we trust Him as our Savior, from judgment, defeat, discouragement, and fear. We now move into a section (chapters 9-11) devoted to the nation of Israel. God has not given up on Israel! Let’s see what we can learn.

On April 22, 1864, the motto "In God We Trust" first appeared on U.S. coinage, being struck on a bronze two-cent piece. The motto was conceived during the American Civil War, both as a way of confessing that the resolution of the conflict lay in the hands of God and as a means of bolstering economic morale.
