“God’s Olive Tree!”

**(Part 24 of a Series in Romans, “The Righteousness of God!”)
Romans 11:16-24**

Romans 11 is all about God *not* being “done” with the nation of Israel! God still has great plans for His chosen nation, even as He still has great plans for all of us! The nation of Israel, on various occasions, was referred to as an “olive tree” (Jeremiah 11:16&17, Hosea 14:4-6). Certainly everyone knew what an olive tree was, as they were common in Israel. The tree resembles an apple tree, and will bear fruit even when very old. The clusters of flowers that come when the tree is in bloom are like lilac. Olives and the oil from olives were used for food, for cooking, for anointing, for lamps. The olive tree will grow in places where many other trees cannot. Israel is God’s olive tree! They were to have a spiritual role, and produce “fruit”, in a world not seeking after God.

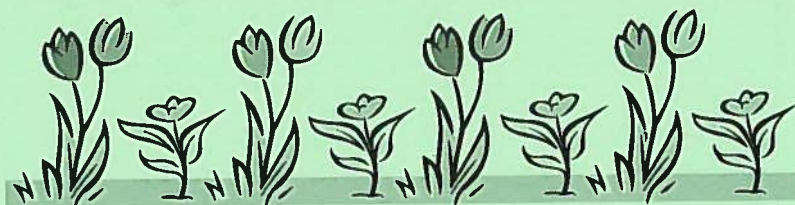

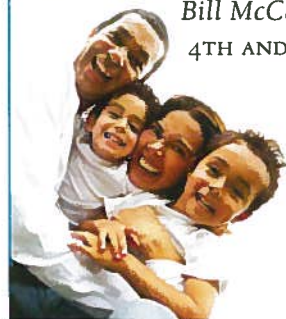

In 1924 President Calvin Coolidge proclaimed the third Sunday in June as "Father's Day." The idea for creating such a day began in Spokane, Washington, back in 1909! Sonora Smart Dodd thought of the idea while listening to a Mother's Day sermon. She had been raised by her selfless father after her mother had died. Her father's birthday was in June, so she chose to hold the first Father's Day celebration in Spokane on June 9, 1910.
