In the early 1950's, God convicted Brother Andrew concerning the people the outside world could not reach, people living in countries behind the Iron Curtain. It was through the words of Revelation 3:2 ("Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.") that Brother Andrew was prompted to begin smuggling Bibles into those countries so those people could be strengthened by God's Word. What was most surprising was that his very presence told them he cared and, with that, they knew God cared and they were not alone. Brother Andrew's action would forever define the work of Open Doors.

When he finally founded Open Doors, it was after he was so famous that he could no longer be a smuggler. But the work continues with God using Open Doors in places where most missionaries cannot go. Open Doors is still a covert operation. Their statement of purpose is "To come along side our brothers and sisters and support them with prayer, Bibles, discipleship, and seminars, all in the midst of persecution."

Please pray for the ministry of Open Doors and for those who face tremendous persecution. Pray that they will hear the Word and be courageous enough to open their heart's door to allow Jesus to come in and give them salvation and peace.
