We are currently taking our children through *The Gospel Story Curriculum*. Through age-appropriate object lessons, activities, and coloring sheets teachers can help young elementary school children to discover Jesus in the Old Testament and New Testament. We encourage you to spend time with your child reviewing the lesson and engaging your child in conversation about what they learned in church that morning. We cannot emphasize enough the important role parents and family play in the spiritual development of a child. We want to be here to help you in every possible way.

CHECK-IN/OUT PROCEDURES:

1. To "check-in" your child, fill out a name tag at the check-in table. Please note any special instructions for your child or allergies your child may have. Keep the stub on the name tag to show when you pick up your child.
2. Sign your child in. Write his/her name and name tag number on the attendance sheet.
3. If you plan on attending church on a regular basis, please fill out a registration form for your child.
4. If we feel your child needs your assistance during the service, we will notify you with a tap on the shoulder. :)
5. To pick up your child, show the classroom teacher the stub from your child's name tag.

Please use discretion if your child has had a fever in the last 24 hours or is visibly sick.

Why Gospel Story for Kids Curriculum?

[Gospel Story for Kids](#) is a unique, curriculum that helps churches and families ground children in the Gospel story from Genesis to Revelation.

At each age level children are taught the Gospel through age-appropriate illustrations, activities, coloring pages, object lessons, and memory verses and *The Gospel Story Bible*, an illustrated children's storybook Bible.

Also, all the children, no matter their age, learn the same story every week to make reviewing the lessons easy for parents.

And lastly, the *Gospel Story for Kids Curriculum* has family devotionals (*Long Story Short* and *Old Story New*) which provide parents with five days of devotions for every lesson in the curriculum. That way, parents can follow up Monday-Friday with what we teach in church on Sunday! See more below...
