## "In Everything Give Thanks!"

It seems only appropriate that in this calendar month of November we should devote a newsworthy article devoted to Thanksgiving. Once again this year the Worship and Music ministry will once again sponsor our annual Homecoming celebration for our returning "snowbirds". But let's be mindful of what this word meant to our forefathers, and just as importantly, what it should mean to us, today.

For instance, did you know that this Thanksgiving observance, which we celebrate on the fourth Thursday each year is viewed worldwide as strictly an American holiday tradition? But how can a tradition start if it's not repeated? According to historical sources, the Pilgrims never held an annual autumn Thanksgiving feast. The Pilgrims did hold a feast in 1621 near Plymouth, Massachusetts, following their first harvest, which has become known as the "First Thanksgiving." However, this feast was never repeated again! Because these early settlers were devoutly religious, they considered a day of thanksgiving should be reserved for praying and fasting; and not a day for indulging themselves with turkey, dressing, and pumpkin pie!

In point of fact, as Christians, we should be thankful at all times and in every way. Paul writes: "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, and <u>in everything</u> give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" [1 Thessalonians 5:16-18]. Notice, Paul does not offer a qualifier. Whether you find yourself in a financial hardship, or suffering from a physical, mental or spiritual affliction, Paul tells us that we should be thankful in all things!

And the best way we can express our thankfulness to God is by demonstrating our trustworthiness. In other words, have we really entrust *everything* to God – our possessions, our family, our health and welfare? If we commit ourselves to God in Christ each and every day and genuinely thank Him for every blessing that He sends our way, then our confidence in Him will withstand the most difficult of trials. Or, as God said, "*Trust Me in this.*"

And so regardless of how or where you spend Thanksgiving this year, please spend time with the Lord in thankfulness for what He has done, is doing, and shall do in both your own life and in the lives of those whom you love.
