Illness Policy Reminder

To help us reduce the spread of illness and in consideration of other students at the center, we ask that:

- A child be free of symptoms of illness (fever, diarrhea, or vomiting) for at least 24 hours
 before returning to the Center. Fever-free means without medication for fever reduction.
- If we send a child home because of illness the child will not be admitted to the center the next day.
