The ZORB Enhances Science Lessons

What a joy it was on Tuesday watching Mrs. Eggold teach a fascinating science lesson to the third grade class. With the use of a zorb, a camera that magnifies an object many times onto a Smartboard, she showed the parts of an egg. Students were able to watch her chipping away at the shell to expose the shell lining. As she continued to open the egg, the students were able to identify the twisted strands, the yolk, egg white and embryo. Mrs. Eggold was able to define the purpose of each part of the egg.

The students were thoroughly engaged and excited about what they were learning. The use of the zorb modeled a great procedure and each student was able to follow through by breaking apart and examining their own egg. What a great learning experience with use of technology!
