Tour Call (262) 251-7140 to schedule a tour to see our school, turn in your application's supporting documents, and fill out the registration paperwork.

Visit Your child will have a half-day to shadow in a classroom and undergo a screening test for grade placement. Parents or guardians will meet with a staff member to discuss any questions or concerns.

Result We will notify you with the status of your application and the results of the screening, such as grade placement and the availability of seats in that grade. The State Department of Public Instruction (DPI) will hold a random selection drawing to award vouchers after the application period is complete.

Place You will be notified of the results of the drawing, either placement in a classroom or on a waiting list via an e-mail directly from the DPI

Eligibility

Eligibility is based on three elements:

1. **Income** - Please see the chart on left. Family income includes the income of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) that live in the same home as the student. If the student's parents/legal guardians are married their income is reduced by \$7,000 when determining income eligibility. Family size includes parents/legal guardians and their children by birth, marriage or adoption that live in the same home as the student.

2. **Residency** - Student's primary residence must be outside of the Milwaukee City Limits.

3. **Previous Enrollment** - If new to the program, the student can not have been enrolled in a private school in the previous year, unless entering 4K, K, or 1st grade.
