Each of you will receive your own unique Scripture verse that will be used to bless you on the day of your confirmation. I hope that you will remember this confirmation verse and that it will be a hope and anchor to you throughout your life.

You will be doing a couple of things with this confirmation verse.

- First: You will memorize it as part of your memory work
- Second: You will be writing a faith story with this confirmation verse.

Here are some guidelines to help you write your

- Tell your faith story
 - When did you see God working in your life to change your life? Events & People
 - How have you experienced God's grace and love in your life?
- How do your verses fit into your story?
 - What do these verses mean according to the Bible?
 - What do they mean to you? Why are they important to you?
 - How do you see your sin and His Grace through these verses?
- Where will you go from here?
 - What does your faith mean to you looking into the future?
 - What encouragement do these verses give you going forward?
- (PARENT PARAGRAPH) Why is your youth confirming their faith important to you?
 - Why are you excited to celebrate this as a family?
 - How will this encourage your family as disciples and a family of faith going forward?

Please type in paragraph form. There is not a limit on how many paragraphs you may use. The entire paper should have a continuous flow to it. The point of this paper is to allow you to share your personal story of how your faith changes your daily life and how the verse you chose (were assigned) plays into that.

This statement of faith should be typed out in 12 point type, Times New Romans, double spaced, and be 1-1.5 pages long. *Your first draft is due no later than November 19th, 2017.*
