About the Curriculum:

Hands that Heal: International Curriculum to Train Caregivers of Trafficking Survivors by the Faith Alliance Against Slavery and Trafficking (FAAST) is internationally written, biblically based and focuses on sex trafficking. This curriculum was developed by over 40 contributing writers/readers from across the world over a 20-month period, and was produced in two editions- Academic (English only) and Community Based.
