The City of Milwaukie, located within 10 miles of downtown Portland, offers the best of all worlds: a small town feel and easy access to Portland and regional activities and services. Within the City, residents regularly engage in city activities as board members, volunteers or simply as participants in a myriad of events organized by local residents and organizations.

Big city excitement and small town charm make Portland, known as "the City of Roses," a favorite destination. Portland, situated approximately 70 miles from the Pacific Ocean where the Columbia River meets the Willamette River, has a magnificent setting, combining sparkling waterways with lush greenery rarely found in urban settings. Portland's historic old town, many galleries and museums, Saturday Market, Waterfront Park, and theater companies will keep you busy for weeks! Also, Portland is just a short distance from the spectacular Columbia Gorge and Multnomah Falls, windsurfing at Hood River, touring at valley wineries, skiing at Mt. Hood, fish watching at Bonneville Dam, and all of the excitement of the Oregon coast.

Portland's award winning mass transit system is one of the most extensive and advanced in the United States. The transit system includes buses and the MAX, an urban light rail line, which recently added a line from Milwaukie.

We are a congregation of devoted followers of Jesus Christ, seeking to grow more in His likeness, striving to reflect His grace and Gospel to our community and world. We are a church with a legacy of strong Bible teaching, inspiring worship, and effective ministries equipping our own and seeing many engage in missions and church ministries.

We are also a church that is currently striving to make Christ-honoring change so that we may continue to connect to our community and effectively make disciples of those who come to us.

Our congregation began as a church plant in 1951 as First Baptist Church - committed to preaching the gospel, reaching people, and taking the good news to the ends of the earth. Today we are known as GracePointe Church. We are in association with CB Northwest - a fellowship of Baptist churches concerned with church planting and serving the needs of our Northwest region.

our leadership

Our leadership team consists of the lead pastor and six lay elders who serve a single three year term or a maximum of two consecutive three year terms on the Board of Elders before a sabbatical year. The Board is a policy board and meets several times a month. Under the direction of the lead pastor, the church's various ministries are guided by ministry directors.

Our Ministry Directors consist of: Pastor of Community and Care; Classic Worship Pastor; Contemporary Worship Director; Pastor of Hispanic Ministry; Pastor of Children's & Family Ministries; Children's & Family Ministries Assistant; High School Director; Pastor of 55+ Ministries; Preschool Director and Assistant. Our staff includes an Office Manager, Communications & Graphic Designer, Receptionist and Custodians.



our ministries

GPKids :: Our desire is to partner with parents to be another voice in your child's life so that your child will know, love and live their life for Jesus Christ.

GPStudents :: We reach out to middle school and high school students, connect them with God, grow them in their relationships with each other and God, and send them into the world to make a difference.

GPAadults :: We provide Adult Classes Sunday mornings where you can connect and build relationships with others. Small Groups are also a great way to connect with others at GracePointe and explore God's Word in a smaller, more intimate setting. There are also Women's Bible Studies, 55+ ministry activities, and more adult events and ministries to be a part of.

GPEspanol :: Our Hispanic Ministry represents the Kingdom of God here on earth with a multicultural church with the advantage that the lessons are completely in Spanish. You can grow spiritually, serve God and develop a family atmosphere with other believers.

Worship :: We have three worship services: Classic, Contemporary, and Hispanic. There are many opportunities for involvement in any Worship service and special creative events.

Missions :: We are committed to building strategic partnerships here in Milwaukie and around the globe to spread the good news of God's grace and to extend His Kingdom. We also regularly have teams serve on evangelistic and community service teams on national and international mission trips.

Community Impact :: Our Backpack Buddies program reaches several elementary schools in the North Clackamas School District by delivering weekly food bags for the weekends to families in need. We have a weekly Bible study and discipleship program to Coffee Creek state correctional facility. We also have a Food Pantry & Clothes Closet that is open once a week and we have a Preschool in the facilities.

Prayer :: There are many ways to connect through the ministry of prayer each week in prayer meetings for men, women, and the whole church.

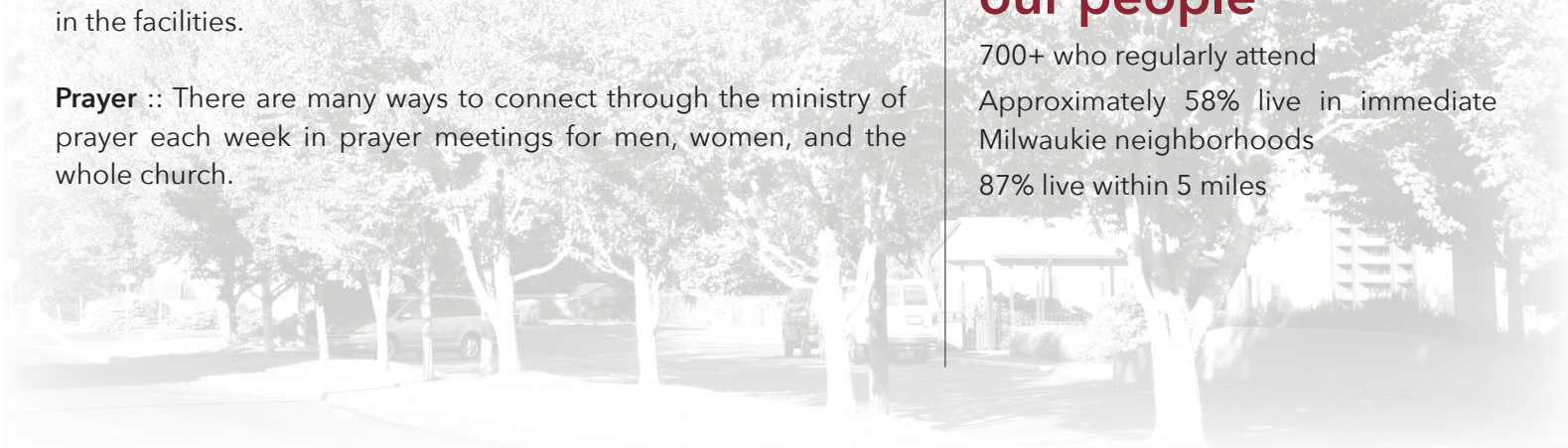
