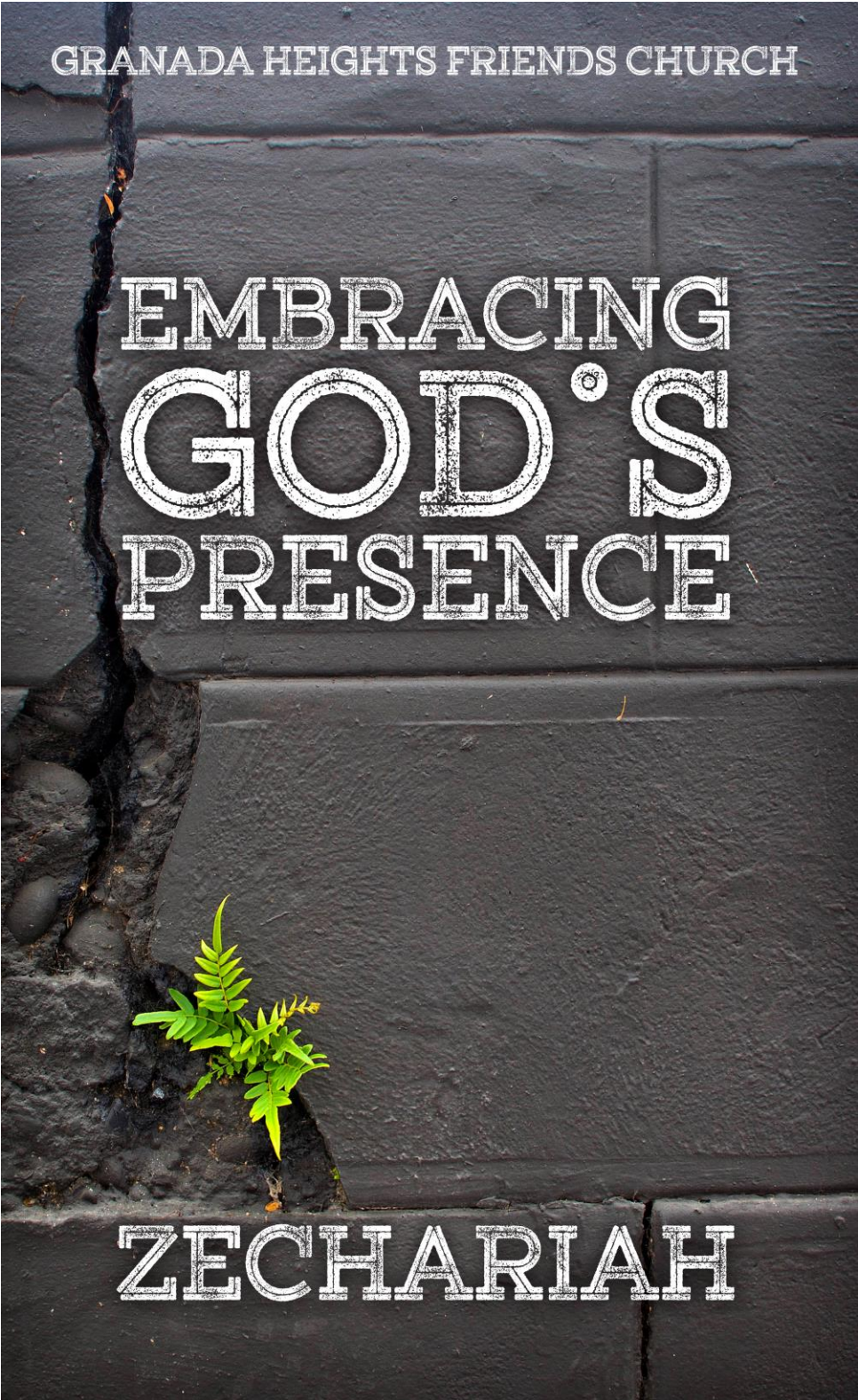

TONY LANDINI Sweden- SMU



Tony, a recent graduate from Biola University, has dreams of using his degree in Bible and Theology to further God's kingdom through pastoral ministry. For the past three years Tony has served as the high school intern, leading small group, teaching and preaching, and most of all being an incredible role model to our high school students.

On June 18th through July 11th, Tony will be joining 6 other gentlemen on a short-term trip to Sweden through Biola's Student Missionary Union. At one time in history, Sweden had been characterized as a Christian nation. Today, statistics show that only 3% of the Swedish population regularly attends church. The increasingly secular society in Sweden has become more and more hardened to the Christian church.

Because of this, Tony and his team will be hosting Gospel-driven sports camps within the Swedish city of Olofström. In the three weeks they spend there they hope to use a variety of sports as an avenue for evangelism and discipleship to the young men in the surrounding community. Their heart is not set on converting every boy in Sweden, but their desire is to share with these young men the overflowing love that Christ has lavished on us. On top of the sports camp ministry, their team will also get an opportunity to interact with the poor of Sweden while serving them in various capacities.

Please be in prayer for Tony and his team as they prepare to travel in a few weeks. Pray that their hearts will be ready to serve and to be a light for Jesus to all that they come in contact with.
