## Kid's Small Group Sunday School at 9:15 am

### Infants through grade 6

Our kid's small groups are a place where children have a chance to encounter Jesus in a fun and interactive way. Group's "Hands On Bible" lessons help our kids from Toddlers through grade 4 experience the Bible through the four major ways they learn. It facilitates a "REAL" life changing experience through Relational (facilitating friendships with peers and teachers), Experiential (fun experiments and object lessons), Applicable (practical ideas to apply biblical truths at home), and Learner Based (the way kids learn best) teaching. Children have the opportunity to get their "Hands On" and their minds around the life giving truth of the Bible, which helps them become fully devoted followers of God. Our fifth and sixth graders participate in Group's Grapple, a challenging and thought provoking program that helps them grapple with issues that face our pre-teens today. The kids pick their own activities online during the week at a safe internet site, that helps them communicate with each other and their teacher between lessons.
