## **From the Pastor's Desk: "Love"**

***2 Chronicles 7:14 "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."***

If the month of January is the month of new beginnings, then the month of February has to be the month of love. While it is the shortest month of the year, it holds that one day that any married man better not forget, Valentines Day. It is for this day in the month that we see hearts hanging from ceilings of the stores, and the candy aisle stocked to capacity. While it is important for us to show the ones that we love that we love them, this should happen more than one day a year. If we only appreciate the ones we love one day a year, they may begin to question, do we love them at all? It seems obvious to us that if we love someone we would want to spend time with them, we would want to talk with them, and we would want to have them as a part of our lives. We do not need a holiday to tell us when to appreciate them; it is something we should do naturally.

Our relationship with God is no different than our relationship with the people on earth we love. Relationships take work so we need to spend time putting in the effort for our relationships to grow. My prayer is that this month you will fall even deeper in love with Jesus, and spend even more time in His presence.


## Children's Ministries

- Praise God for church leaders and ministry volunteers. Pray that the people at CCAN will grow in their faith and that they will be a witness for Jesus in their places of work and spheres of influence. Pray that they will have opportunities to make friends and share their faith.
- Pray for encouragement for the children and their families involved in an after school program.
