"I was surrounded by family and friends while being baptized with my husband & daughter." - Su Mohr

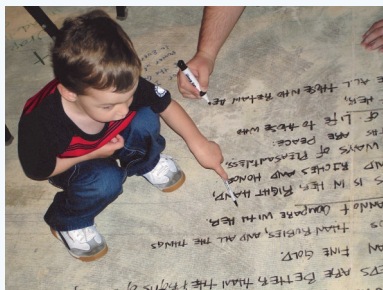
