that prepared the box. Be getting a picture (just an informal snapshot will do) of you and/or your family to enclose with your note. Pray for the child that God will direct your specific box to. Don't forget, Halloween candy will be going on sale soon. This is a great chance to purchase those hard candies and lollipops for your box. Any extras can be sent with the folks going to work in Charlotte to use as filler as they work on the 'screening line'. [Tootsie rolls are allowed but no other chocolate or soft candies or foods. Most boxes are shipped to receiving countries in sea-going cargo shipping containers where extreme hot temperatures are reached.]
