The Autry's started Parkway Baptist Church in March 2002, and the church grew from 13 founding families to 1,000 people in attendance. The church became known for a focus on families, a heart for community outreach, missions, and prayer ministry. As a pastor, Brian had a particular focus on speaking to and leading men to become spiritual leaders. The church became involved with church planting in Virginia, Colorado, Boston, Romania, and the Philippines. The Autry's also served as missionaries for the Southern Baptist North American Mission Board in evangelism and church planting.
