Class Options for Theology @9

(Classes begin April 13, 2014)

"Evangelism: Sharing the Good News when and where it is desperately needed."

This class will use an "in house" curriculum and will feature two basic components. First, utilizing classic textbooks by JI Packer and John Piper, we will learn the theological foundation for evangelism. We will come to see how the sovereignty of God and our responsibility to witness go hand in hand. We will also, at least to a limited extent, survey the essence of missions and see how, despite much current teaching, everything we do is not missions. Second, we will discuss and develop a practical means of speaking to others about the Good News of King Jesus. This class, hopefully, will be perfect for those who have never had any evangelistic training. At the same time, hopefully, it will encourage those who have had previous training and want/need to be spurred on to a more consistent witness to Christ. Of note, class participation will be a necessity for us to get the most out of our resources and time together. Participants will be expected to read approximately 25-40 pages per week and to contribute to class discussion. Some (not much) Bible verse memorization should also be anticipated. The class will be led by Davis Gooding.

Behold Your God: Rethinking God Biblically.

There are two truths that underpin this study: 1 - A vital knowledge of God is not merely a tool to reach something more significant. 2 - The believers view of God is the most distinguishing and influential factor in his or her life. Our understanding of God affects every area of our lives. The class will be 12 weeks long and a workbook will be provided. The workbook brings us into contact with God's self-revelation in the Bible and helps us apply these descriptions of Him to our lives. This class will be led by David Walker.

Cults & Major Religions -

As Christians living in the 21st century, we are faced with increasing religious diversity. People in cults and other religions may be showing up on your doorstep, at your job, or maybe even in your own family. You might be wondering, How can I possibly "always be prepared to give an answer" (1 Peter 3:15)? This study will help prepare you by examining the marks of a cult and what really attracts and keeps people in these religious groups. Special attention will be given to the teachings and origins of the world's most popular false religions: Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormons, Eastern Spirituality (Hinduism, Buddhism, & New Age philosophy), and Islam. This class will be led by Alex Crain.

Who Is Jesus?

Ten 30-minute video sessions taught by Dr. Del Tackett, (teacher of the truth project). This Focus on the Family presentation will answer the question Who is Jesus and why it must be answered, how to answer the question is Jesus the only way? It will examine the promises and the prophecy of God and how they were fulfilled by Jesus and the historical accuracy and accounts of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection and more. The class will be led by Buddy Pritchard.
