## Theology@9 Classes:

**Biblical Theology** - understand not only what the Bible teaches, but to do so in the context of the Bible's own progressively revealed and progressively developing story-line. 12 week course. Teacher – Wes Loveday

**How to Study the Bible** - Over the next 12 weeks we will consider: the most important methods of interpreting the Bible, the Bible's structure, and some specific study tools and methods to allow us to better understand the bible. The goal of this class is to give you a greater love for God and his Son by assisting you in learning how to fruitfully read and understand the Bible. Teacher – Joel Bradberry

**Money** - The purpose of our time together will be to help us better understand God's intention for how we use our money and possessions. Our focus will be centered upon what the Bible teaches about God's purpose for wealth, gracious giving, spending, budgeting, debt, saving and how to develop a heart which values money rightly. 6-week course beginning October 4<sup>th</sup>. **Guidance** - The world and even Christians have developed some unbiblical ideas about how God guides our decisions - and yet the Scriptures give us some amazing truths about how God does guide us. We'll be looking at Anxious or Restful decisions, God's Sovereignty, God's Will and how we can apply these truths to our
