New Theology@9 Classes will begin on July 3rd:

This course is continuing into its 2nd semester:

New Testament - A 26 week course to understand the big picture of each book of the New Testament, the continuity between the books in the NT, to realize the Promises God has kept to His People from the OT and to hear God speak to us today through His Word and so to be challenged in our lives. This class is taught by Buddy Pritchard in room #27.

Christian Discipleship - we will consider in more detail, the last command that Jesus gave to his followers - the command to go and make disciples. As followers of

Jesus ourselves, we have a keen interest in knowing how we can best be obedient to that command – to go and be about the work of making disciples - what we'll refer to as the work of "discipling." This class will be taught by Joel Bradberry in the Library.

Barry Taylor and Davis Gooding will teach these classes in room #28:

Baptist Essentials - Can Christians do fine with God, and without the church? To answer that question, we need to think carefully about what the Bible says about the church; to think about the theology of the church. What we'll find is that far from being optional, the church is central to God's plan. Far from being something that is reserved for scholars in ivory towers, the theology of the church matters for you and me because God has spoken. This is a 6-week course.

Christians in the Workplace - Americans spend more time working than any activity other than sleeping. For something so central to our daily lives, so central to our lives in general, it's important to ask the simple question, "Why do I work?" This is a 6-week course.
