HCF Family - marvel at God's creation that is all around us as we hike St Mary's Falls near Stuart's Draft, VA on Saturday, Sept. 17th. We will meet at the church office at 8:00am and return by 7:00pm. Bring/wear bathing suit, t-shirt, old shoes you don't mind getting wet, water, a bag lunch, and money for fast food dinner. The hike is not steep or strenuous, but takes about 1 hour each way and involves multiple mountain creek rock crossings and climbing some small embankments. The reward is at the top where under the falls you can jump from 10, 20 or 30 foot perches into a natural 54 degree water swimming hole.
