**Systematic Theology** - Systematic Theology seeks to arrange the whole of Biblical teaching into logical, topical divisions. This, then, allows for the formulation of doctrine and helps us to construct an overall view of the nature of God, as He has revealed Himself in Scripture, and the manner in which He interacts with His creation. This 12 week class will be taught by Barry Taylor.

**Missions** - Missions exists to increase the worship of God through the praise of His glory in the hearts of His people. Students will hear, consider and understand the Biblical message that God's passion for His own glory is His central motive for world evangelism in missions. This 12 week class will be taught by David Walker.
