Old Testament Overview – Part 1 – Why study the Old Testament? First, because the Old Testament reveals the character of God in a way that the New Testament does not and secondly, the Old Testament tells us about Jesus. This is being taught by Joel Bradberry and meets in room #28.

Behold Your God – A 12-week study that focuses on God’s self-revelation in the bible, helping individuals to apply the descriptions of God to all of life. Each week’s lesson will include a short biographical sketch of a significant figure from Christian history, a review of the week’s study through the workbook and an interview from a contemporary minister whose life and labors reflect these same truths. This class is being taught by Barry Taylor and meets in the Library.

Biblical Manhood & Womanhood - Biblical Manhood & Womanhood - What does it mean to be a man? What does it mean to be a woman? Do men and women have different roles? Some might say those are the wrong questions, that we need a new flexibility when it comes to issues of gender and sexuality. Thankfully, the Bible speaks to these issues. And we’ll listen to what scripture says in our core seminar on Biblical Manhood and Womanhood. This class is being taught by David Walker and meets in room #27.
