



After visiting Staten Island in the wake of Hurricane Sandy, we noticed that Staten Island is not only the "forgotten borough" of NYC, it is also the forgotten borough of missions and church planting. To our utter astonishment, we discovered that there was, at that time, only 1 Southern Baptist Church, and only a small handful of Evangelical churches that believe the Bible is the inerrant Word of God, and Jesus is the only way of salvation. Due to this lack of Christian influence, being forced from their homes by Sandy, and the daily grind of living in the capital of the world, many Staten Islanders experience persistent hopelessness.



What a tremendous turnout we had this past Easter Sunday! Even with the Spring Break calendar not working in our favor (several of our families were out of town), 323 people were on our church campus Sunday to celebrate our risen Lord. Praise God! Please pray that much fruit, both evangelistic impact and deepening discipleship, would occur in the lives of those who came. Thank you for the warmth and hospitality you displayed to our guests. You all are such a blessing and joy to me!

PASTOR OF WORSHIP & DISCIPLESHIP SEARCH TEAM

On March 29th, our church body elected 6 people to serve on our Pastor of Worship & Discipleship Search Team as we seek to move forward in enhancing and growing these ministries. The elected members are:

Please be in prayer for this group and for the individual they will eventually present before our church body as the next called pastoral staff member at HBC. I would encourage you to pray daily about it. Pray that God would grant both wisdom and discernment for this team, and pray that the Lord would continue working in the life of the person and their family who he is leading to this place and confirming his will to both to the individual and to the church in discernible ways.

THE NEW CAMPUS AT TELL STREET

What a tremendous blessing we received from the Kentucky Baptist Convention in being approved for \$20,000 in funding for the Tell Street campus. We did not expect to receive half of that amount. The Lord is good. Right now, we are working to fill out the required documentation of the funding and also examining the legal aspects of ownership of the Tell Street property. We will likely form a 501c3 organization in Indiana in order to obtain full legal requirements for this ministry as an umbrella of Hawesville Baptist Church. Our plan is to host a Vacation Bible School at the Tell Street church property this summer and launch a Grand Opening service (complete with a new name for the campus) a few weeks later. Please be in prayer for this ministry. Pray that God would lay on our hearts a burden to reach the people of Perry County, Indiana, and that he would raise up workers for his harvest. What a tremendous opportunity we have!

WELCOMING OUR GUESTS AND NEW MEMBERS:

These past few weeks and months, we have been welcoming many new guests and members. I cannot impress upon you the importance of making first impressions lasting ones. We must not simply think of ourselves as a friendly church; we must BE a friendly church. If you don't know who someone is, go out of your way to welcome them; invite them to your Sunday School class, out to lunch, or to a small group meeting. Find them on Facebook; send them a thank you card. We want to make people feel welcome and at home. It is my prayer that when people walk out the doors of our church, they will leave having never been more loved by a group of believers.

GIVING THROUGH THE MORE THAN ENOUGH CAMPAIGN:

Thank you so much for the way you have consistently given toward the new Family Life Center! Beginning last December, our church is now making monthly payments on our loan. The current balance is just under \$400,000. The monthly payments on this loan are approximately \$3,700.00. I am so thankful for the ministries this new facility is providing, and we are trusting in the Lord to continue to supply our needs through the generosity of his people. 

This year we will be going to Crossings Camp, which will take place at Cedarmore. This is open to both middle school and high school students. There are a few churches from our county who are going


the same week, so it should be a great chance for us to grow closer w/ other area youth groups.

A deposit of \$50 will be required to hold a spot for camp.






