Rebranding Proposal

What and Why

In our continued efforts to “Grow Disciples and Multiply Churches who Glorify God and Transform Communities,” it has become increasing evident to members of this church and members of leadership that our name is creating confusion and disinterest in the minds of the unchurched. It has become a barrier to our local efforts in seeing God’s kingdom expand, and a hinderance to people further exploring our church fellowship.

Because our desire is to make the gospel as accessible as possible (without comprising Biblical integrity) we believe that our brand (including our name) could be modified to remove these hinderances.

Therefore, it is the unanimous recommendation of the Leadership Board that we move forward in the rebranding process. A change of name requires a 2/3 vote.

Again, we want to stress, that this does NOT mean a change in values, beliefs, or denominational affiliation. We remain firmly committed to our broader denominational family.

As such, our proposal is as follows:

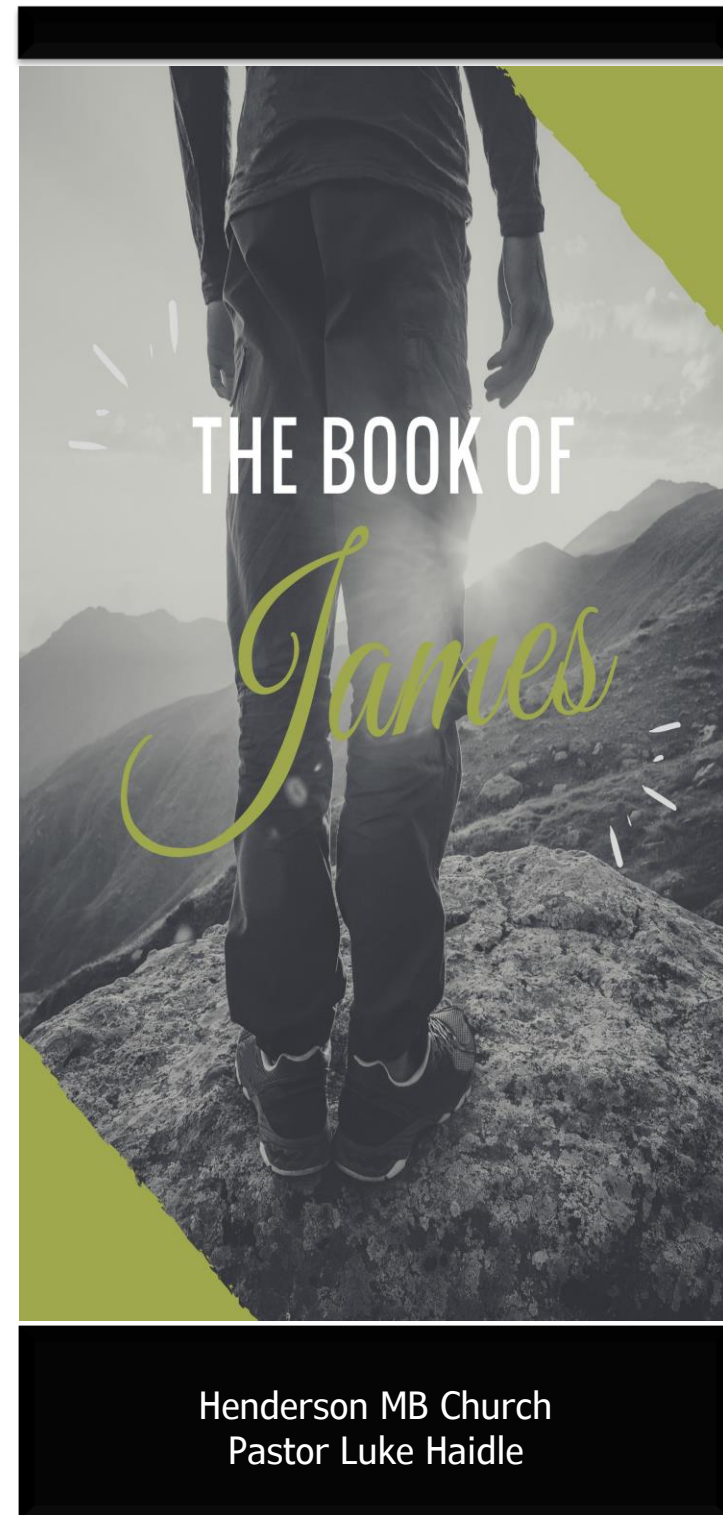
