ABOUT OUR GUEST SPEAKER:

Jon Sanders is the lead pastor at the Rescue Church in Flandreau, South Dakota. He and his wife Jessica have been married for 20 years have 3 wonderful children, Justin, Jenni and James.

He has been a career fire fighter since May 2000, but in summer of 2002 he answered God's calling to go into pastoral ministry. Through a series of events and open doors God led his family to the small town of Flandreau, South Dakota to plant what is now The RESCUE Church.

In 2009, God gave a clear vision to reproduce the church in rural communities across South Dakota, the Midwest and beyond through a multi-site church planting strategy. Currently, The RESCUE Church has 5 campuses in South Dakota, Illinois and Jamaica as well as an internet campus.

In 2014, Jon returned to the fire service as a firefighter with Sioux Falls Fire Rescue as well as continuing his roll as full-time pastor.
