### **WaterCup Counseling Services**

## NORTH AMERICAN OPPORTUNITIES

### **VBS Family Trip to Baker City, Oregon**

March 23-28, 2014

Minimal cost. Meals and housing provided by Blue Mountain Church.

Deadline: team will be formed by February 16, 2014. A team of 10 to 15 (includes youth and adults) with Vacation Bible School experience. The team will be leading a VBS for community children and will work on church building remodeling projects.

### **New York City**

July 7-17, 2014

Approximate cost per person: \$1500

A team of eight to twelve people from hbc will be working with the Metro New York Baptist Association. The team will conduct a workshop for pastors and church leaders teaching them how to reach out and minister to families with special needs, including adapting church ministries to those needs. The team will also lead a Special Needs Vacation Bible School and Day Camp, which will serve as a ministry model for participants. Pastor Barry will lead a coaching cluster for pastors. Applications are being accepted now for this opportunity.

## INTERNATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

### **Pomabama, Peru**

August 3-16, 2014

Approximate cost per person: \$2000.

Working with Southern Baptist International Mission Board (IMB) missionaries Russ and Sherri Fleetwood. Possible mission activities may include helping the Fleetwoods with an event for high school students. Speaking Spanish is helpful but not absolutely necessary as interpreters can be hired. The team will be working at 10,000 feet and in a location with poor medical facilities, so good health is imperative. Six to eight people will be needed for the team. Applications are being accepted.

### **Portugal**

July 7-14, 2014

Approximate cost per person: \$2000

A team of 4 to 5 people will go to Lisbon, Portugal to support IMB (International Mission Board) church planting missionaries Mark and Hannah Bustrum. This could be the first of many opportunities to work together with the Bustrums. They have requested we come to prayer walk as we get to know their ministry,

the culture and the people they are working with. Missionaries repeatedly testify that preceding on-location prayer provides the spiritual breakthrough needed as they engage in new areas of ministry. Along with prayer walking, team members will have the opportunity to encourage the Bustrums as well as those with whom they are in the process of discipling. Applicants for this trip should be willing and able to spend a greater part of each day walking through the areas where Mark and Hannah minister. Specific training will be provided and expected for this team in regard to prayer walking.

### **Nairobi, Kenya**

A team of 4 to 5 men. This is the first trip hbc is taking to Kenya. hbc hopes to go each year and plan to allow for women to join as well in future trips.

Approximate cost per person: \$3500

Working with Southern Baptist International Mission Board (IMB) missionaries Chad and Miriam Pumpelly. The Pumpelly's ministry is essentially summed up in 4 ways: Prayer, evangelization, discipleship, and mobilization. As Islam is the main religion in this part of Africa, it is of utmost importance that the Gospel gets to these people. Chad Pumpelly works almost exclusively with college students in Nairobi University where he mobilizes them alongside churches from the States who come for a mission trip to go to either the Pokot people group or the Digo people group.
