"Welcome Home" Study Begins

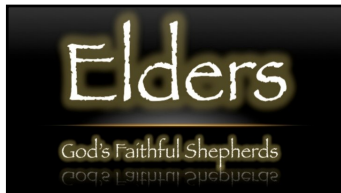
