Ability to motivate believers to apply Biblical truths to their lives especially when they are discouraged or wavering in their faith; to challenge others to spiritual growth.

Faith:

Ability to discern the purpose & will of God for the future of His work & trust Him to accomplish His purpose regardless of the circumstances. **I Corinthians 12:9**

Giving:

Ability to accumulate & generously distribute material resources to God's work or people with such wisdom & cheerfulness that the Church family are encouraged & blessed; to earn & manage money so it may be given to support the Ministry. **Romans 12:8**

Mercy:

Ability to detect hurt & feel genuine empathy & compassion for those who are suffering in any way in the Church family & to meet those needs with cheerful support which reflects Christ's love to those in crisis or in pain. **Romans 12:8**

Administration:

Ability to organize & manage people, resources, & time for effective ministry; to coordinate many details & execute the plans of leadership. **I Corinthians 14:40**

Hospitality:

Ability to make others, especially strangers, feel warmly welcomed, accepted, & comfortable in the Church family; to coordinate factors that promote fellowship. **I Peter 4:9-10**

Missions:

Ability to adapt to a different culture in order to reach unbelievers & help believers from that culture grow in their faith; to start new churches & oversee their development.
