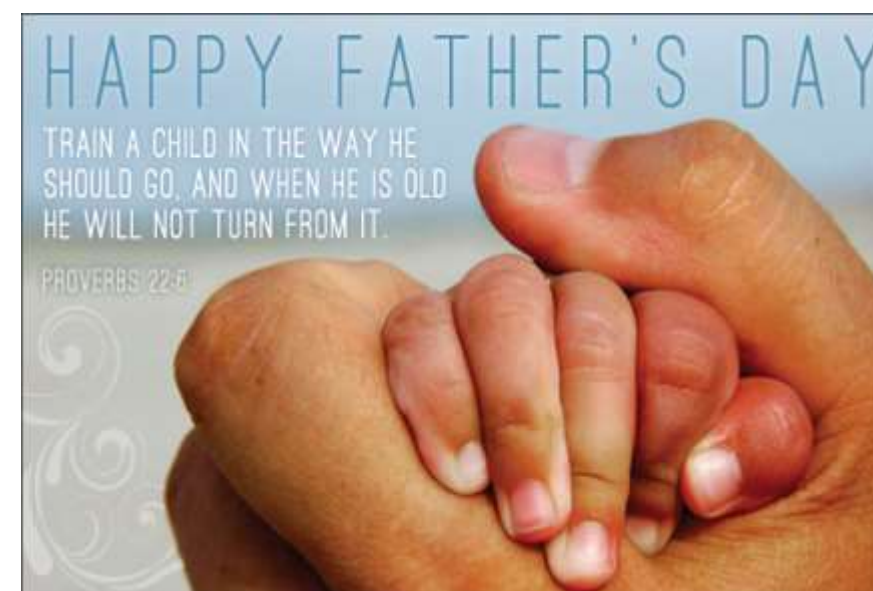

I am embarrassed to admit this, but I recently discovered I was running my tires tremendously underinflated. The mud tires on my truck are a ten-ply tire (means they are really thick) and can hold eighty-two pounds of pressure cold. Three of them were in the upper fifties and one was actually in the forties in relation to air pressure. When I called the local dealer he recommended I run around seventy pounds of pressure in them. Not only did it lift my truck, but it will also lessen uneven tread wear on the tires, which means they last longer. What I did not expect was what it would do to my gas mileage. I gained 1.8 miles per gallon of gas, all from properly inflating my tires.

Why do I share this story? Because the Bible says we are to edify one another. Edify means to build up. As I preached last month, we are to pray for those who are no longer in our fellowship. We are to keep loving them and love on them as often as we are given opportunity. Some of the stories from the Iraq veterans are absolutely miraculous. This is a must read for those who are in the military or have loved ones in the military. The promises in Psalm 91 are for every Christian to claim, not just for the military. Learn how to meditate on and claim the promises of God for your protection and well being.

In the coming days, whether fueled by the inconsistencies of circumstance, frustrations, or the exhilaration of triumph, we boast only in Christ, basking in the grace of Calvary and the hope of the empty tomb. We are called to do life in Him!
