Shopping for school supplies is just around the corner!

The boys at the Methodist Children's Home Society will be in

need of a school supply filled backpack again this year. The backpacks should be available for pick-up in the Narthex, the end of July. All filled backpacks need to be returned to the church by the last Sunday of August.



In education, we call it Each One, Teach One. A student who understands a concept will help another student to understand it better. At Holy Cross we can call it Each One, Recruit One! We have many present and former

Kids Hope mentors who know first hand what a difference one caring adult can make in the life of an at risk child. If you have considered participating in this ministry, but aren't quite sure how it works, or whether it's right for you, talk to someone who knows first hand. Spending one hour per week together can be rewarding for both the mentor and the child!

This year we had 19 mentors and 19 prayer partners, but 35 children were referred to the program. Please consider joining Kids Hope this Fall. We will provide training in September and new mentors will begin in October. We are planning for returning mentors to begin sooner.

## Patio Party


Join us Saturday, July 23rd, at 7 pm. Your hostess for this Patio Party is Marilyn Grable! Bring an appetizer


