

# Avoiding Error by Emphasis

*...It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God. Matt 4:4*

An accurate rendering of the main point of this verse would be, Man lives by every word that is proceeding from the mouth of God. The term "word" in this scripture comes from *rhema*, a Greek word meaning a freshly spoken word from God full of power. The "proceeding word" is what God is emphasizing at the moment, for the hour and the day we are in now. Many a move of God at some point ceased to keep moving on with God when they refused to receive further revelation from a proceeding word. They continued emphasizing yesterday's word while neglecting or even outright rejecting what God was saying for a new day. When we shout what heaven is whispering and whisper what heaven is shouting it is called error by emphasis. This kind of error is epidemic in the church but if we determine to stay Spirit led and keep His manifest presence our top priority we will... *hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches* (Rev. 3:6) and keep moving on with God.
